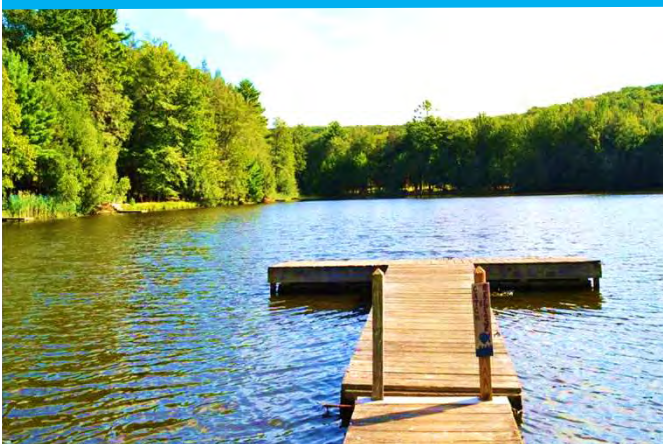

Parking: Maximum of 7 cars in the driveway. Please pre-register your cars (Year, Make, Model, License Plate #, and State), as it is required by the community. Note: Parking is not allowed on the road/street.

Front Door Access: 24/7 keypad entry – 4 digit code will be made within 24 hours of your stay.

Unlocking: Enter the 4 digit code and use the handle to open. From the inside, you can set the thumb turn to the vertical position to keep the door unlocked.

Locking: From the inside, set the thumbturn to horizontal. The door will automatically lock from the outside.

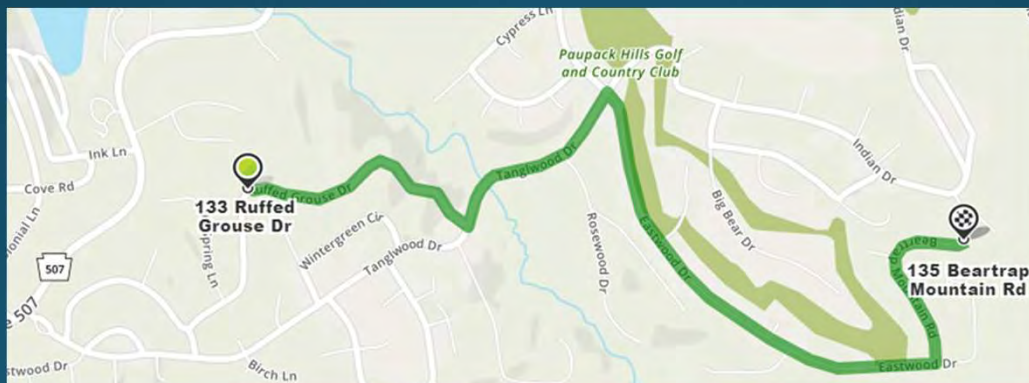

- ✓ Read all House and Community Rules (all Guests of the property).
- ✓ Please leave our home in a similar condition as you checked in. The cleaning fee that was already paid for covers laundering of linens, towels, bathroom, and general clean-up (vacuuming), etc. Trash removal, Fridge, and Grill cleaning are not included.
- ✓ Please feel free to use the dishwasher. Starter dishwasher soap is located under the sink – Be sure to only use dishwasher soap in the dishwasher.
- ✓ There are starter garbage bags under the sink.
- ✓ Please dispose of your garbage at the community dumpsters located 1 mile away. Under no circumstances should garbage be left outside. Additional fees will apply if garbage is left in/on the property.
- ✓ Please ensure refrigerator is empty and clean upon check-out.
- ✓ Our home uses a septic tank – please do not place anything other than toilet paper in the toilet.

Extra charges will apply if any of the above rules are not followed.



Directions to the Garbage Bin: Head south on Bear Trap Mountain Road, stop sign make the right on Eastwood Drive, Tanglwood drive make the left, *Ruffed Grouse drive* make the right, drive 0.4 miles, the dumpster will be on your right-hand side behind the wooden fence.

Our home is located within the beautiful Tanglwood Lakes Community. Please adhere and follow the below rules provided by the community. Any fines assessed by the community will be deducted from the security deposit or charged in excess of security deposit.

- 1) Please respect quiet hours between 11:00 P.M. to 8:00 A.M.
- 2) Fire within the fire pit must not be larger than 3 feet high, in a manageable state with a means of putting it out immediately.
- 3) Golf course: The golf course is private property and is not part of Tanglwood Lakes community. No one is allowed on the golf course unless they paid to play at Paupack Hills Country Club. Anyone found on the golf course is subject to trespassing charges by the State police.
- 4) The use of fireworks are strictly PROHIBITED.
- 5) No parking allowed on the street at any time. Cars will be towed at owner's expense.
- 6) Please adhere to the speed limit (15 MPH) at all times within the community.
- 7) Parking pass must be displayed when accessing community amenities (i.e. Tanglwood Beach area).



Fire Safety



To use the indoor fireplace (main floor):

- 1) Make sure Flue is open! Pull lever at top of chimney opening forward.
- 2) We recommend using a duraflame log and 1 or 2 wood logs. Please purchase as there is no available firewood on our property.
- 3) Light fire and close screen. You must attend an open fire at all times.
- 4) Make sure fire is COMPLETELY out before closing flue. Make sure there are no embers burning.
- 5) Wait until ashes are cold (usually overnight), remove ash, and dispose along with your other refuse.



To use the outdoor fire pit:

- 1) Lay one or two handfuls of tinder down in the center of the fire pit. You can use newspaper, small sticks, etc.
- 2) Stack the wood logs on top of the tinder in a “teepee” structure. You can purchase bundles of logs at the local grocery store (Dutch’s Market).
Note: We do not have excess firewood on the property.
- 3) Light a match and light the tinder. Watch as the flames from the tinder reach up to the kindling and start the kindling on fire.
- 4) Watch the fire at all times to ensure everyone's safety and ensure it continues to burn satisfactorily. If the fire wanes, add more kindling. If the fire grows larger than you desire, let it die down until it is smaller.
- 5) Please ensure fire is COMPLETELY out before heading back inside the home.

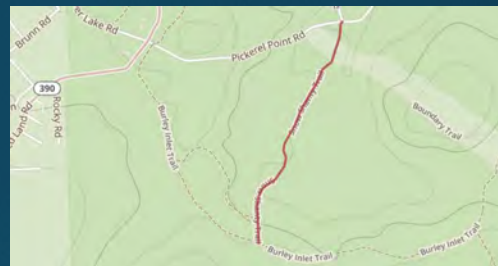


Tanglwood Lake Trail: The Nature Trail is a 34 acre preserve located on Tanglwood Drive at the bottom of the hill. The Nature Trail includes a one mile walking path which starts and concludes on Tanglwood Drive. Wildlife, native plants and a trout stream are a few of the experiences available to hikers.

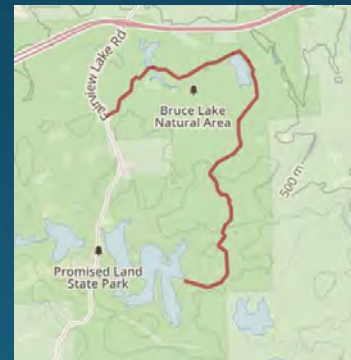
Promised Land State Park has 18 hiking trails. These trails range from 0.3 to 7.1 miles in length. The most popular trails are [Snow Shanty Trail](#), [Bruce Lake Trail](#) and [Village Trail](#).

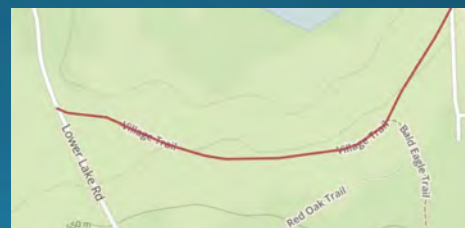
- Snow Shanty Trail
 - 0.7 miles long and begins at 1,737 feet altitude. Traveling the entire trail is 1.3 miles with a total elevation gain of 161 feet. This trail connects with the following: Burley Inlet Trail and Boundary Trail.



- Bruce Lake Trail
 - It is a hiking, biking, and horse trail. It is within Delaware State Forest, Bruce Lake Natural Area, and Promised Land State Park. It is 7.1 miles long and begins at 1,769 feet altitude. Traveling the entire trail is 14.2 miles with a total elevation gain of 1,327 feet. Near the trailhead there is parking. Along the trail there is a water. This trail connects with the following: Boundary Trail, Brown Trail, Panther Swamp Trail, Egypt Meadow Trail, Telephone Trail, Overgrown, 2016-8-10, West Branch Bruce Lake Trail, Overgrown, 2016-8-10, Rock Oak Ridge Trail and Egypt Meadow Trail.



- Village Trail
 - Village Trail is a hiking and biking trail in Greene Township, Pennsylvania. It is within Promised Land State Park. It is 0.6 miles long and begins at 1,755 feet altitude. Traveling the entire trail is 1.2 miles with a total elevation gain of 73 feet. This trail connects with the following: Bald Eagle Trail.

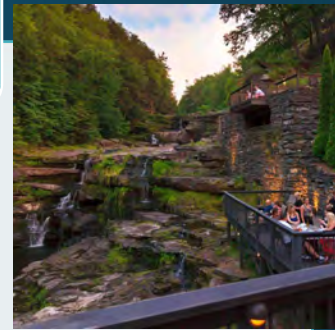
