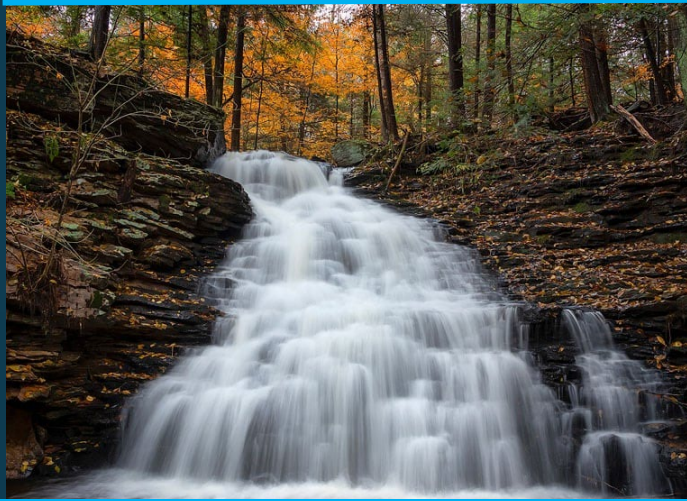
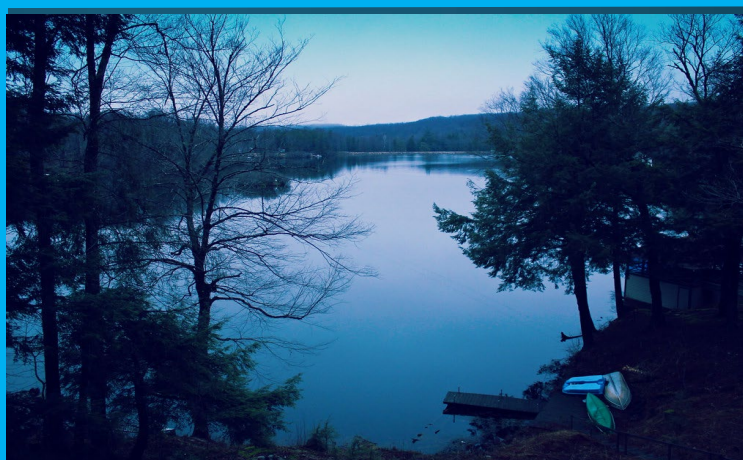
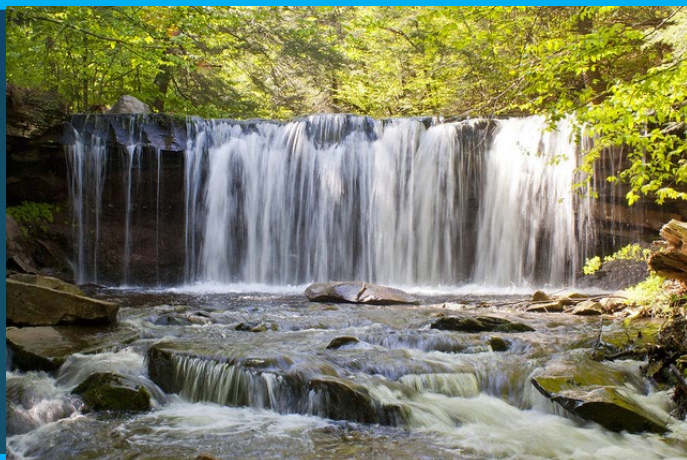

We offer the following amenities:

- Free WiFi
- Smart TVs
- Heated indoor Pool and hot tub
- Pool Table
- Fireplace
- Washer/Dryer
- Linens and (1) towel per guest
- Kitchen basics (pots, pans, dishes, cups, etc.)
- Starter paper products (hand towels and toilet paper)
- Soap

Please bring the following: trash bags, additional paper hand towels, toilet paper, extra towels (incl. pool towels), firewood, dish/dishwasher soap, bug spray, sunscreen, cooking oil, cooking spices, ground coffee, and any other items to ensure your comfort during your stay!

Parking: Maximum of 10 cars in the driveway.

Note: Parking is not allowed on the road/street.

Front Door Access: 24/7 keypad entry – 4 digit code will be made available to you within 24 hours of your stay.

Unlocking: Enter the 4 digit code and use the handle to open. From the inside, you can set the thumb turn to the vertical position to keep the door unlocked.

Locking: From the inside, set the thumbturn to horizontal. The door will automatically lock from the outside.

- ✓ Read all House Rules (all Guests of the property).
- ✓ Please remember to keep the hot tub and pool covered when not in use and upon check-out.
- ✓ Please leave our home in a similar condition as you checked in. The cleaning fee that was already paid for covers laundering of linens, towels, bathroom, and general clean-up (vacuuming), etc. Trash removal, Fridge, and Grill cleaning are not included. Please clean the home prior to checkout.
- ✓ Please feel free to use the dishwasher. Starter dishwasher soap is located under the sink – Be sure to only use dishwasher soap in the dishwasher.
- ✓ There are starter garbage bags under the sink.
- ✓ Please dispose of your garbage at the dumpster located at the end of the driveway. Under no circumstances should garbage be left outside. Additional fees will apply if garbage is left in/on the property.
- ✓ Please ensure refrigerator is empty and clean upon check-out.

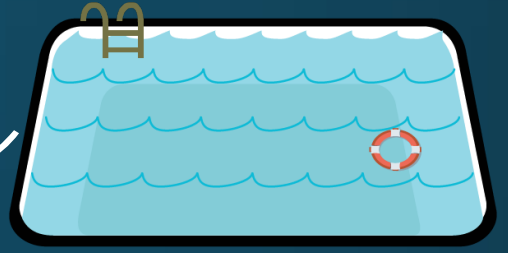

Pool Rules



- No glass of any kind in the pool area.
- No Running and No Diving allowed in the pool area.
- Each day when you're done using the pool and hot tub, please cover them both for the night. Please also make sure they are covered prior to check out. The dehumidification system needs to run continuously. If you do not cover the pool and hot tub, it will lower the water levels and prevent the water from being filtered and heated.
- Please bathe before using the pool.
- Please do not pee in the pool.
- This is Stress Free Zone. Relax and Have Fun!

- Max Occupancy – 6 people.
- Please cover the hot tub when not in use.
- No Alcohol / Drinks or Food in the hot tub area.
- Please bathe before using the hot tub.
- Please do not pee in our hot tub.
- This is Stress Free Zone, Relax and Have Fun!

House Rules

- ✓ The swimming pool is ready to use. If you choose to use it, please make sure you and your guests understand all the pool rules before use.
- ✓ The house uses a septic system that is sensitive. Please flush only toilet paper down the toilet and do not discard grease down the kitchen drain.
- ✓ Please be courteous to the neighbors next door and observe the quiet hours starting at 10 PM every night when you are out on the patio, backyard, or driveway.
- ✓ Please be sure to remove all garbage from the fridge and the home and place it in the garbage bin at the end of the driveway. This includes cleaning the grill, fire pit, and fireplaces. Garbage days are Fridays.
- ✓ Checkout is at 11 AM. The housekeeper will arrive at 11 to begin preparing the home for the next guests. Please respect the checkout time as to not interfere with the housekeeping team and cause any inconvenience to the next guests.
- ✓ Please be sure to turn all the thermostats to 60 degrees F.

Fire Safety



To use the indoor fireplace (lower level):

- 1) Make sure Flue is open! Twist lever at top of chimney opening.
- 2) We recommend using a duraflame log and 1 or 2 wood logs. Please purchase as there is no available firewood on our property.
- 3) Light fire and close screen. You must attend an open fire at all times.
- 4) Make sure fire is COMPLETELY out before closing flue. Make sure there are no embers burning.
- 5) Wait until ashes are cold (usually overnight), remove ash, and dispose along with your other refuse.

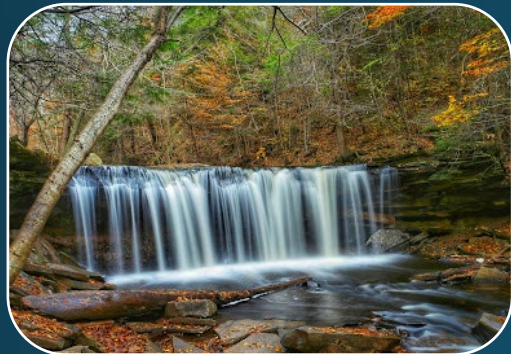

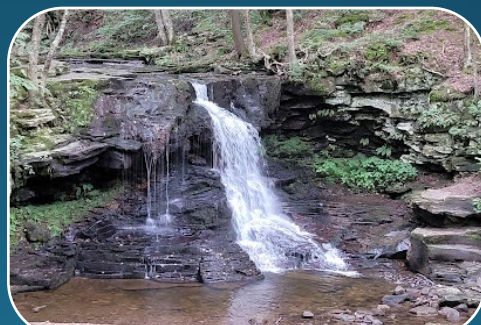


Forksville Covered Bridge

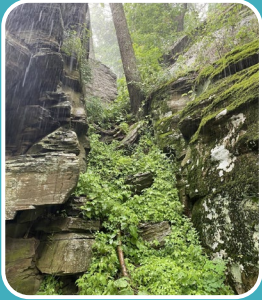

Ticklish Rock

Length: .5mi Elevation Gain: 137ft Skill: Easy

Ticklish Rock is a 0.5 mile out and back trail located near Muncy Valley, Pennsylvania that offers the chance to see wildlife and is good for all skill levels. The trail is primarily used for hiking, walking, and running.

Check-out Reminders

- Please depart no later than 11:00 A.M, so we can prepare the house for our next guest(s). Late check-out is not available unless previously agreed on, as the housekeeper will be on the property to clean at 11:00 A.M.
- Collect all trash and drop it off at the dumpster, located at the end of the driveway.
- Load and run the dishwasher.
- Remove any food items from the refrigerator.
- Turn off lights, ceiling fans and other electronics.
- Please set all the thermostats to 60 Degrees F.
- Ensure hot tub and pool are covered.
- Close and lock all doors, windows, and sliding glass doors.
- Have a safe journey home and please leave us a review mentioning your favorite memory of your stay!

Frequently Asked Questions

- 1) When will the front door code be provided?

We provide the code within 24 hours before check-in.

- 2) Is the kitchen stocked with cooking supplies?

The kitchen has a coffee maker, electric tea kettle, toaster, pots, pans, measuring cups, silverware, plates, cups, microwave, and a dishwasher.

- 3) Is early check-in/late check-out available?

Please check with us if this is available on your check-in/check-out day. This depends on if we have guests checking out/in on the same day.

- 4) How often are the pool and hot tub cleaned?

The pool and hot tub are both professionally cleaned and sanitized by a professional pool and spa company on a weekly basis. Depending on the length of your stay, the technicians may be scheduled to stop in for the routine cleaning during your stay.
