Note: Parking is <u>not allowed</u> on the road/street.


<u>Front Door Access</u>: 24/7 keypad entry – 4 digit code will be made available to you within 24 hours of your stay.

**Unlocking**: Enter the 4 digit code. Rotate the thumb turn and unlock the deadbolt. From the inside, you can set the thumb turn to the vertical position to keep the door unlocked.

**Locking:** From the outside, press the Schlage button once and rotate the thumb turn to lock the deadbolt. From the inside, set the thumbturn to horizontal. The door will automatically lock from the outside.





Please turn all the thermostats to 60 degreed F.

- ✓ Read all House Rules (all Guests of the property).
- ✓ Please remember to keep the hot tub covered when not in use and upon check-out.

## Sauna Rules



- This is a dry sauna. No Liquid on the sauna rocks.
- Temperature is approx. 165° to 185° F [74° to 85° Celsius]. Use at your own risk!
- Recommended use is maximum 15 minutes.
- Max Occupancy 7 people.
- EXIT IMMEDIATELY, if uncomfortable, dizzy or sleepy!
- Do not use if Pregnant, in poor health or have medical conditions, such as HBP, Diabetes without prior medical consultation from a doctor.
- Breathing heated air with consumption of alcohol, drugs, or medication may cause unconsciousness.
- No children under 16 years unless accompanied by adult.
- Do not use alone, or after rigorous exercise.
- No Alcohol / Drinks or Food in the sauna.

### House Rules

- ✓ The swimming pool is ready to use. If you choose to use
  it, please make sure you and your guests understand all
  the pool rules before use.
- ✓ The house uses a septic system that is sensitive. Please flush only toilet paper down the toilet and do not discard grease down the kitchen drain.
- ✓ Please be courteous to the neighbor across the street and observe the quiet hours starting at 10 PM every night when you are out on the patio, backyard, or driveway.
- ✓ Please be sure to remove all garbage from the fridge and the home and place it in the garbage bin at the end of the driveway. This includes cleaning the grill, fire pit, and fireplaces. Garbage days are Mondays.
- ✓ Checkout is at 11 AM. The housekeeper will arrive at 11 to begin preparing the home for the next guests. Please respect the checkout time as to not interfere with the housekeeping team and cause any inconvenience to the next guests.
- ✓ Please be sure to turn all the thermostats to 60 degrees F.



#### To use the indoor fireplace (main floor):

- 1) Make sure Flue is open! Twist lever at top of chimney opening.
- 2) We recommend using a duraflame log and 1 or 2 wood logs. Please purchase as there is no available firewood on our property.
- 3) Light fire and close screen. You must attend an open fire at all times.
- 4) Make sure fire is COMPLETELY out before closing flue. Make sure there are no embers burning.
- 5) Wait until ashes are cold (usually overnight), remove ash, and dispose along with your other refuse.



#### To use the outdoor fire pit:

- 1) Lay one or two handfuls of tinder down in the center of the fire pit. You can use newspaper, small sticks, etc.
- 2) Stack the wood logs on top of the tinder in a "teepee" structure. You can purchase bundles of logs at the local grocery store (GIANT is closest).
  - Note: We do not have excess firewood on the property.
- 3) Light a match and light the tinder. Watch as the flames from the tinder reach up to the kindling and start the kindling on fire.
- 4) Watch the fire at all times to ensure everyone's safety and ensure it continues to burn satisfactorily. If the fire wanes, add more kindling. If the fire grows larger than you desire, let it die down until it is smaller.
- 5) Please ensure fire is COMPLETELY out before heading back inside the home.

This 3,107-acre WMA contains the largest freshwater wetland in southeastern New York, and is a state designated Bird Conservation Area. Its 1,920-acre wetland is a birdwatcher's dream, drawing birders during the spring warbler migration and spring and fall waterfowl migrations due to the influx of interesting birds. Both bald eagles and osprey are commonly seen from the many easy access points. The forested uplands that surround the wetland provide a peaceful setting where one can enjoy a quiet walk in the woods. There is a substantial chestnut oak forest as well as ponds, fields, marshes, and swamps.

Length: 5.8mi Elevation Gain: 1,062ft

Features a waterfall. The trail is rated as moderate and is primarily used for hiking and nature trips.


